

Last October, the Portuguese Dental Hygienists Association - **APHO** held its 20th Congress, an event that took place in Lisbon and was chaired by Dr. Carlos Lopes, President of the Organizing Committee.

This Congress ended with the election of the APHO social bodies for the next four years with Dr. Fátima Duarte as President.
